NIGHT-BEFORE FRENCH TOAST, Bob McMahon

- 1 10 ounce long, thin loaf of French bread
- 8 large eggs
- 3 cups milk
- 3/4 teaspoon salt
- 4 teaspoons granulated sugar
- 1 tablespoon vanilla
- 1 tablespoon coffee liquor (optional....
 I just add more vanilla!)
- 2 tablespoons butter, cut into small pieces
- 350° pre-heated oven



Grease a 13" X 9" baking pan. Cut bread in 1-inch-thick slices and arrange them in one layer on the bottom of the pan. In a large bowl, beat the eggs and then add in the rest of the ingredients except the butter and mix thoroughly. Pour the mixture uniformly over the bread, cover with foil and refrigerate 4 to 36 hours. To bake, uncover the pan, dot the bread with butter and place the pan in the oven. Bake 45 to 50 minutes until the bread is puffy and lightly browned. Remove from the oven and let the French toast stand about 5 minutes before serving. SERVES 8. ENJOY!
